1.2 **Adopted Expedited Emergency Game and Fish Rules: Special Spring Turkey Hunt**

1.3 **6213.0520 TRANSFER OF LICENSES.**

1.4 A person may transfer a license to a person with a severe disability or critical illness  
1.5 as follows:

1.6 A. the license to be transferred must be accompanied by a letter signed by the  
1.7 commissioner that includes the license number and the name of the person transferring the  
1.8 license as well as the name of the person receiving the license; and

1.9 B. the person receiving the license must be participating in a hunting or fishing  
1.10 program sponsored by a nonprofit organization.

1.11 **6236.0810 WILD TURKEY PERMIT AREA DESCRIPTIONS.**

1.13 Subp. 2. **Permit area 501.** Wild turkey permit area 501 consists of that portion of  
1.14 the state lying within the following described boundary:

1.15 Beginning at the intersection of the southern and eastern boundaries of the state;  
1.16 thence along the southern boundary to U.S. Highway 63, Fillmore County; thence  
1.17 along U.S. Highway 63 to State Trunk Highway (STH) 30, Olmsted County; thence  
1.18 along STH 30 to County State-Aid Highway (CSAH) 13, Olmsted County; thence  
1.19 along CSAH 13 to STH 57, Dodge County; thence along STH 57 to U.S. Highway  
1.20 52; thence along U.S. Highway 52 to STH 19; thence along STH 19 to ~~the west bank~~  
1.21 ~~of the Little Cannon River; thence along the west bank of the Little Cannon River~~  
1.22 ~~to the north bank of the Cannon River; thence along the north bank of the Cannon~~  
1.23 ~~River to~~ U.S. Highway 61; thence along U.S. Highway 61 to U.S. Highway 63;  
1.24 thence along U.S. Highway 63 to the eastern boundary of the state; thence along the  
1.25 eastern boundary to the point of beginning.

2.2 Subp. 4. **Permit area 503.** Wild turkey permit area 503 consists of that portion of  
2.3 the state lying within the following described boundary:

2.5 63, Fillmore County; thence along the southern boundary of the state to State Trunk  
2.6 Highway (STH) 22, Faribault County; thence along STH 22 to County State-Aid  
2.7 Highway (CSAH) 29, Faribault County; thence along CSAH 29 to CSAH 3, Waseca  
2.8 County; thence along CSAH 3 to STH 30; thence along STH 30 to STH 22, Blue  
2.9 Earth County; thence along STH 22 to U.S. Highway 14; thence along U.S. Highway  
2.10 14 to STH 60, Blue Earth County; thence along STH 60 to CSAH 26, Blue Earth  
2.11 County; thence along CSAH 26 to CSAH 15, Le Sueur County; thence along CSAH  
2.12 15 to STH 99, Le Sueur County; thence along STH 99 to CSAH 11, Le Sueur County;  
2.13 thence along CSAH 11 to CSAH 26, Le Sueur County; thence along CSAH 26 to  
2.14 CSAH 11, Le Sueur County; thence along CSAH 11 to STH 19, Le Sueur County;  
2.15 thence along STH 19 to Interstate Highway 35 (I-35); thence along I-35 to CSAH  
2.16 70, Scott County; thence along CSAH 70 to CSAH 23, Dakota County; thence  
2.17 along CSAH 23 to STH 50, Dakota County; thence along STH 50 to STH 3, Dakota

3.5 **6236.1060 TURKEY HUNT QUOTAS.**

3.6 Subpart 1. Open permit areas. The following wild turkey permit areas are open  
 3.7 for the 2012 spring wild turkey season with the quotas on numbers of permits for time  
 3.8 periods A to D established below. An unlimited number of licenses are available for  
 3.9 time periods E to H:

4.1 Subp. 2. **Permits for disability hunts.** For the 2012 spring wild turkey season, the  
4.2 following permits are available for disability hunts:

4.3 A. For wild turkey permit area 507, one additional permit per time periods A  
4.4 to D is available for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt on the  
4.5 Sand Prairie Wildlife Management Area. Capable Partners is the sponsoring nonprofit  
4.6 organization.

4.7 B. For wild turkey permit area 510, four additional permits per time periods A  
4.8 to D are available for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt on the  
4.9 Becklin Homestead Park Wildlife Management Area. Capable Partners and the Isanti  
4.10 County Sportsman's Club are the sponsoring nonprofit organizations.

4.11 C. For Camp Ripley Military Reservation, within wild turkey permit area 508,  
4.12 up to an additional 60 permits shall be issued for time period B for individuals with  
4.13 disabilities participating in a special hunt. One nonhunting mentor shall accompany each  
4.14 disabled hunter. The St. Cloud Veterans Administration is the sponsoring organization.

4.15 D. For wild turkey permit area 507, two additional permits are available for  
4.16 both time periods A and C for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt  
4.17 at the Prairie Woods Environmental Learning Center. Midwest Outdoors Unlimited and  
4.18 Prairie Woods Environmental Learning Center are the sponsoring nonprofit organizations.

4.19 E. For wild turkey permit area 505, two additional permits per time periods A  
4.20 to D are available for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt on the  
4.21 Minnesota Valley National Wildlife Refuge. Capable Partners is the sponsoring nonprofit  
4.22 organization.

4.23 F. For wild turkey permit area 507, one additional permit per time periods A  
4.24 to D is available for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt on the  
4.25 Sherburne National Wildlife Refuge. Midwest Outdoors Unlimited is the sponsoring  
4.26 nonprofit organization.

5.1 G. For wild turkey permit area 508, one additional permit per time periods A to  
5.2 D is available for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt on the Crane  
5.3 Meadows National Wildlife Refuge. Midwest Outdoors Unlimited is the sponsoring  
5.4 nonprofit organization.

5.5 H. For wild turkey permit area 507, 13 additional permits per time periods  
5.6 A to C and 18 additional permits for time period D are available for individuals with  
5.7 disabilities participating in a special hunt. Midwest Outdoors Unlimited is the sponsoring  
5.8 nonprofit organization.

5.9 **6236.1075 SPECIAL HUNTS FOR MILITARY PERSONNEL.**

5.10 For the 2012 spring wild turkey season, the following permits are available for  
5.11 special hunts for military personnel:

5.12 A. For Camp Ripley Military Reservation, within wild turkey permit area 508,  
5.13 up to an additional 60 permits shall be issued during time period C and another 60 permits  
5.14 during time period D. The Minnesota Army National Guard is the sponsoring organization.

5.15 B. For Arden Hills Army Training Site, within wild turkey permit area 510, up  
5.16 to an additional 20 permits shall be issued for each of time periods A to C. The Minnesota  
5.17 Army National Guard is the sponsoring organization.

5.18 **EFFECTIVE PERIOD.** The expedited emergency amendments to Minnesota Rules,  
5.19 parts 6236.0810 and 6236.1060, expire July 1, 2012. Minnesota Rules, part 6236.1075,  
5.20 expires July 1, 2012.
