Subpart 1. 100 Series. This subpart applies to deer permit areas 100 to 199. Legal 9.2 bucks may be taken for a 16-day period beginning the Saturday nearest November 6. In 9.3 hunters choice, managed, or intensive deer permit areas, antlerless deer may be taken 9.4 throughout this season. In lottery deer permit areas and in special hunt areas, antlerless 9.5 deer may be taken only by permit throughout this season and only within the deer permit 9.6 or special hunt area specified on each hunter's permit, except as specifically authorized by 9.7 statute. Antlerless deer may not be taken in bucks-only deer permit areas. A person who is 9.8 authorized by statute to take a deer of either sex without an either-sex permit and who 9.9 is licensed for season option A may take an antlerless deer without a permit, except in 9.10 those lottery deer permit areas where no either-sex permits are offered and, in youth-only 9.11 antlerless deer permit areas, and in bucks-only deer permit areas. 9.12

In lottery deer permit areas and in special hunt areas, antlerless 9.16 deer may be taken only by permit throughout this season and only within the deer permit 9.17 or special hunt area specified on each hunter's permit, except as specifically authorized 9.18 by statute.
