- 1) Priorities are subject to change based on results of dam safety inspections, readiness of local project sponsors, opportunities for piggybacking projects, etc.
 2) All cost estimates are preliminary; actual costs will depend on final project design and construction bids received.
 3) MS Section 103G.511 authorizes matching grants to local governments and requires legislative approval of projects or grants of \$250,000 or more.
 4) MS Section 103G.515 authorizes the state to pay the full cost of dam removals under certain conditions.
 5) "Remove/modify" means a final decision has not been made on whether the dam will be removed or modified.
