General Specifications

- 1. All corner, brace, and gate posts (6" x 16') are set to a depth of 6 ft. All line posts (4" x 14') are set to a depth of 4 ft.
- 2. The horizontal braces are constructed using the 5" x 16' posts, pins, HT wire and strainers.
- 3. The brace posts (6"x 16') are set 16' o.c. from corner and gate posts.
- 4. The line posts (4" x 14') are spaced on maximum 20' intervals.
- 5. Two strands of HT wire are spaced 6 9" above the woven wire around the entire perimeter except the gate opening.
- 6. Staples used to fasten the woven wire are set loose enough to allow the wire to move.
