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This project consists of 65.8 acres in section 36 of Blooming Grove Township, Waseca County. It is located in the Crane Creek watershed, tributary to the Straight and Cannon Rivers. There are 4 drained, restorable wetland basins on the property consisting of approximately 9 acres but much of the site consists of hydric soils and there is considerable potential for enhanced water retention and wet meadow restoration.

Following the establishment of a conservation easement, the wetland basins will be restored by interrupting tile lines. The seasonally inundated, wet meadow component of the site will be restored by planting a diverse mix of wet meadow forbs and grasses.

This site is adjacent to the Moonan WMA and will therefore serve to improve the effectiveness of that site by creating a larger, contiguous habitat and by enhancing watershed function. The upper Crane Creek watershed has been substantially drained in recent decades and much aquatic habitat value and watershed function has been lost as a result. More projects like this one are needed to restore those values.


