Crow Wing	<b>Rotary Riverside Park</b> City of Brainerd	Acquire 37-acre addition with 1,300 feet of Mississippi River front to existing city parkland containing 4,600 feet of river front within the City of Brainerd, MN. This combined area will provide opportunities for cross country skiing, snow shoeing, boating, walking and nature study.	37	\$17,500
Sherburne	<b>Bailey Point Acquisition</b> City of Elk River	Acquire a 22.58-acre parcel of historic and scenic property with over 3,300 feet of natural, largely untouched shoreline at the confluence of the Mississippi and Elk Rivers.	22.58	\$39,000
Ramsey	<b>Fish Creek Natural Area</b> City of Maplewood	Acquisition of approximately 48 acres of land contiguous to 148 acres of Ramsey County open space along Fish Creek. The property is contains rolling hills, bluff top and steep slopes. Views from the bluff tops look out over the Mississippi River Valley and Fish Creek.	48	\$406,000
