

## Recent Remediation Grants

City of Andover	Kelsey Round Lake Park Restoration	Prairie restoration of native grasses and forbs in the open field. Woodland restoration by removing 14 acres of buckthorn in the riparian forest buffer and replanting native tree species suitable for that area.
City of Corcoran	Lake Jubert Restoration	Restoration of woodlands and wetlands by removal of nonnative/exotic species, replanting with native species, and long-term management to control exotics and establish healthy native plant communities on 30 acres to be donated by owner.
City of Duluth	Grassy Point Acquisition	Acquisition of 7.38 acres of land for future trail construction.
City of Eagan	Caponi Acquisition	The City will acquire fee title to a 10-acre parcel adjacent to Patrick Eagan Park and a 20-acre parcel on Quigley lake.
City of East Bethel	White Cedar Forest	Acquire 50 acres for access to the Cedar Creek Natural History Area.
City of Elk River	Top of the World Acquisition	Acquire 78.0 acres of quality dry oak forest between two existing park parcels. Combined, the three parcels form a 330-acre block of contiguous forest along a greenway and trail corridor.
City of Inver Grove Heights	Heritage Village Park	Verify property lines by survey and install protective fencing and signage; Restore approximately 11 acres of floodplain forest and 14 acres of prairie.
City of Inver Grove Heights	Southwest Natural Area Acquisition	Acquisition of 3 acres for the southwest natural area.
City of Mendota Heights	Pilot Knob	Acquire 8.25 acres that has significant ecological, scenic, cultural and historic value. Site is eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places. Serves as a key connection in an existing wildlife habitat corridor.
City of Rosemount	Wiklund Woodland Restoration	Restore 10.5 acres of woodland. Invasive exotic woody shrubs will be cut and the stumps will be treated with herbicide and/or controlled by prescribed burning. Seedlings will be sprayed with herbicide. Native shrubs will be planted in selected areas to replace the exotic shrubs that were removed.
City of Sauk Rapids	Pattison Woods	Acquire approximately 7.16 acres. Part of a larger wetland complex threatened by development.
City of St. Cloud	Paulson Property	Acquire 30.81 acres. Surrounded on three sides by existing Neenah Creek Regional Park. Identified by MCBS as having significant biodiversity containing an oak forest natural community and is a maturing stand of northern pin and red oak with pockets of white/bur oak. Listed as a natural heritage site due to granite outcroppings
County of Chisago	Little Lake Preserve	Acquire 245.8 acres of land. This acquisition would extend the county property around Little Lake and conserve a historical family farm.
County of Isanti	Horseshoe Lake	Acquire approximately 176.15 acres at Horseshoe Lake
County of Meeker	Kingston County Park	Stream bank stabilization along the North Fork Crow River bank. Plant red twig dogwood and seed grasses

		(1 acre).
County of Winona	Winona County Restoration	Betterment activities will consist of shaping, compost/soil enhancement, water and sediment control and native seeding of the 18.6 acres.
County of Wright	Stanley Eddy Regional Park	Acquire 188 acres of wetlands, hardwoods and pasture along with recreational easements at Stanley Eddy Regional Park, now 655 acres of hills and big wood forest.
DNR - Fish and Wildlife	Etna Creek AMA	Acquire 63.2 acres to expand the Etna Creek aquatic management area, parcel 3.
DNR - Fisheries	Bottle Lake AMA	Acquire 35.4 acres with almost 3,000' of undeveloped lakeshore at the outlet of Lower Bottle Lake.
DNR - Forestry	Zumbro River Spooner Property	Acquire 150 acres and restoration of planting native trees, controlling invasive species and re-establishing wetlands.
