Bring your own bicycle or choose one of the following:

Rent a bicycle from the Galloping Goose (\$18 per bike)

Call Galloping Goose Rentals at 218-731-7181 or 218-282-1063 and ask for the special Trail Grand Opening rate. Payment in advance is required. Bikes will be delivered to park for event. Tandem bikes, child trailers, and surreys are available for additional cost.



Reserve a seat on a trail shuttle (free)

Call the Lakes Area Community Center at 218-862-5222 to reserve a seat. Space is limited. Walk-ups may not be able to be accommodated. All trail rides begin from Glendalough Trail Center. Trail rides depart at 10 a.m. (back before ceremony), 11:45 a.m. (immediately after ceremony), 12:45 p.m., 1:45 p.m., and 2:45 p.m.

Drive or ride to Glendalough State Park:

State Park Vehicle Permits (\$3 per vehicle)

Personal vehicles entering the park need a state park vehicle permit. Daily permits may be purchased at the park entrance for a discounted rate of \$3 per vehicle for this event. There is no fee to ride a bicycle into the park.



Battle Lake Shuttle Bus (free)

A shuttle bus will run from the Lakes Area Community Center at 9:30 a.m. and leave the park at 11:45 a.m. It will run again at 12:15 p.m. and leave the park at 1:45 p.m. Call the LACC at 218-862-5222 to reserve a seat. Space is limited.
