NOTES

- ¹ **Backpack campsites** are more than a quarter-mile from parking.
 - ² **Walk-in campsites** are less than a quarter-mile from parking.
 - ³ **Accessible campsites** are located on flat terrain near accessible toilet facilities and, where feasible, are equipped with electricity.
 - ⁴ **Shower/flush toilet facilities** generally are available from Memorial Day through Labor Day. Water is turned off in fall when freezing temperatures are imminent and turned on in spring once the threat of frost has passed. All shower and flush toilet facilities are accessible except those at Cascade River and Monson Lake state parks. Showers but no flush toilets are available at Beaver Creek Valley, Minneopa, and Zippel Bay state parks. Flush toilets but no showers are available at Afton, Fort Snelling, Hill Annex, Lake Maria, and Soudan Underground Mine state parks.
 - ⁵ **Camper cabins** will open in 2009 at Afton and Glacial Lakes state parks. At least one cabin in each park is accessible, except at Maplewood and Lake Maria state parks. Access to some year-round use cabins may be limited in the winter.
 - ⁶ **Accessible lodging** facilities are available at St. Croix, Scenic, Itasca, and Tettegouche state parks.
 - ⁷ **Geocaching Demo Parks** loan out GPS units to anyone who wants to try geocaching. If you need help getting started, the staff at the Demo Parks will gladly offer instructions, along with periodic Geocaching 101 programs.
 - ⁸ **Rentals:** Due to limited staffing, equipment rentals at some parks may only be available on the weekends, unless you call ahead to make other arrangements.
 - ⁹ **Snowshoeing** is available anywhere in the park except on groomed ski trails.
 - ¹⁰ Due to construction of a new visitor center, parking will be limited at **Grand Portage State Park** in 2009. Access to High Falls will remain open, but trails may be re-routed.
