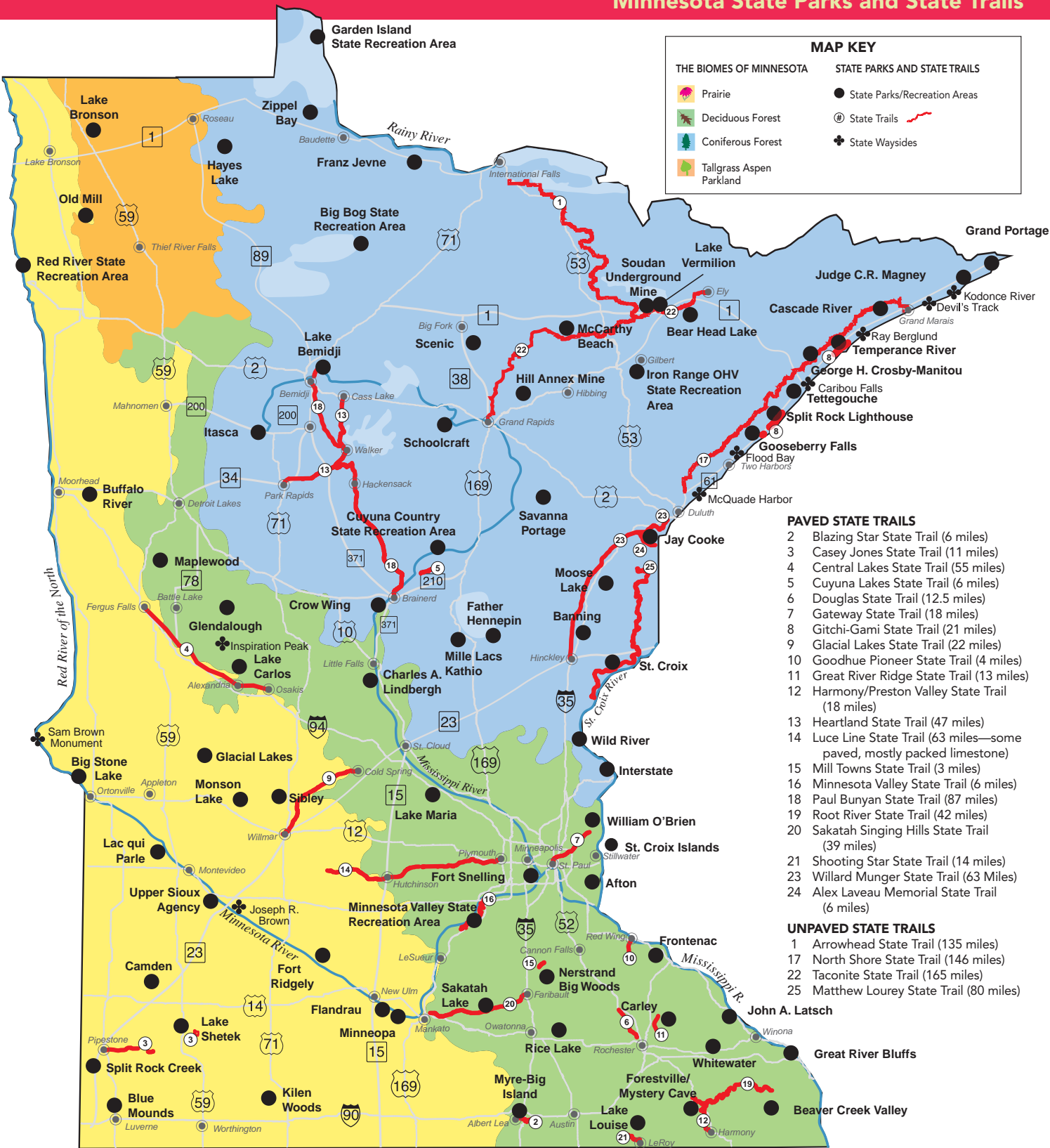

- Luce Line State Trail (63 miles—some paved, mostly packed limestone)
