 Trail surfaces include accessible aggregate and bituminous










Steepest trail section (max grade 9%)

Accessible flush toilets located in trail center, interpretive center, picnic area, and campground.

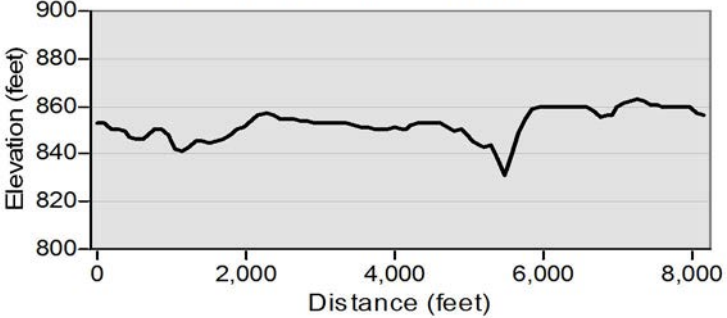
Accessible vault toilets located in picnic area and adjacent to camper cabins.

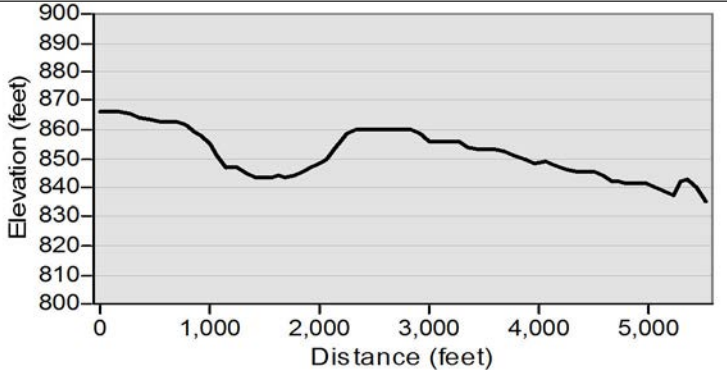
