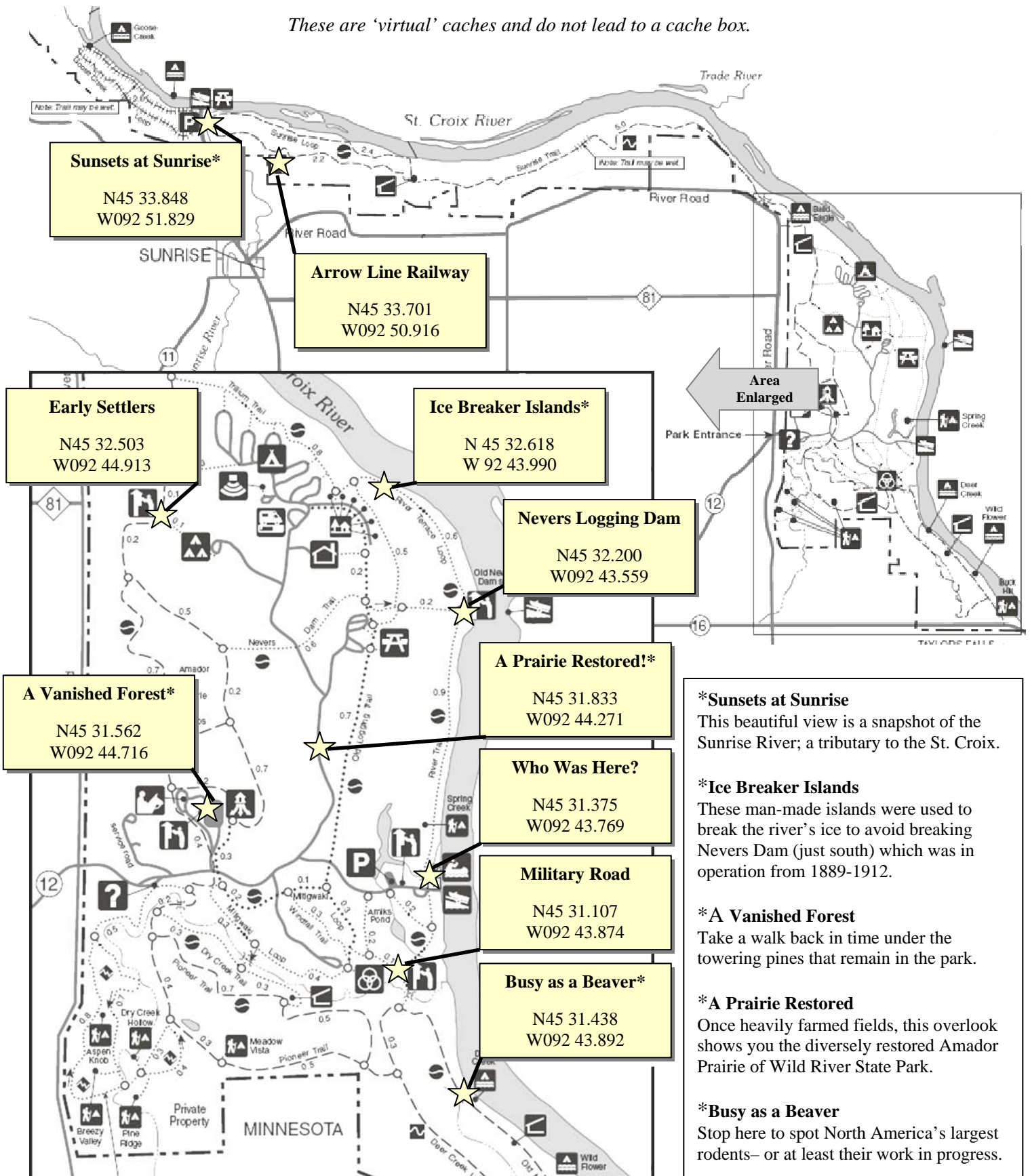


# (WAY)POINTS OF INTEREST

Use your GPS to find these unique places within Wild River State Park.  
Remember, always stay on designated trails!

*These are 'virtual' caches and do not lead to a cache box.*



- \*Sunsets at Sunrise**  
This beautiful view is a snapshot of the Sunrise River; a tributary to the St. Croix.
- \*Ice Breaker Islands**  
These man-made islands were used to break the river's ice to avoid breaking Nevers Dam (just south) which was in operation from 1889-1912.
- \*A Vanished Forest**  
Take a walk back in time under the towering pines that remain in the park.
- \*A Prairie Restored**  
Once heavily farmed fields, this overlook shows you the diversely restored Amador Prairie of Wild River State Park.
- \*Busy as a Beaver**  
Stop here to spot North America's largest rodents- or at least their work in progress.
