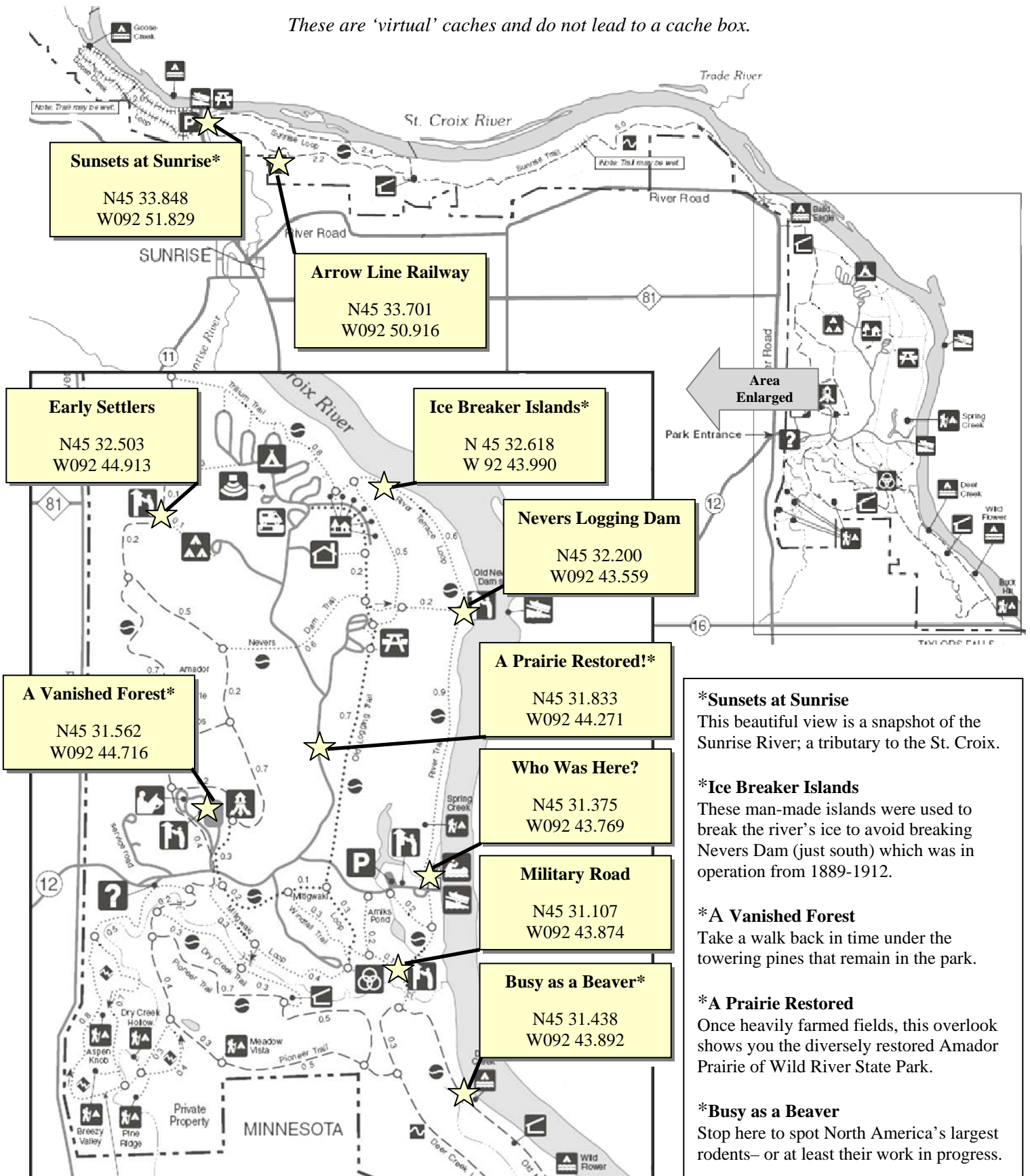


(WAY)POINTS OF INTEREST

Use your GPS to find these unique places within Wild River State Park.
Remember, always stay on designated trails!

These are 'virtual' caches and do not lead to a cache box.



- *Sunsets at Sunrise**
This beautiful view is a snapshot of the Sunrise River; a tributary to the St. Croix.
- *Ice Breaker Islands**
These man-made islands were used to break the river's ice to avoid breaking Nevers Dam (just south) which was in operation from 1889-1912.
- *A Vanished Forest**
Take a walk back in time under the towering pines that remain in the park.
- *A Prairie Restored**
Once heavily farmed fields, this overlook shows you the diversely restored Amador Prairie of Wild River State Park.
- *Busy as a Beaver**
Stop here to spot North America's largest rodents- or at least their work in progress.
