




Project Learning Tree® How to Use PLT's E-Unit Access Codes

First Time Access with an Access Code

1. Go to the [PLT Store](http://shop.plt.org) (<http://shop.plt.org>)
2. Select "Log In" (upper right corner).



3. If you haven't already created a PLT account, select "Create Your PLT Account". If you already have an account, log into your account. Note: If you are a new user, you will be prompted to complete the Site Registration page. (**All fields must be completed** in order to gain full access.)




Create Your PLT Account

4. Once you are logged into your account, select "Your Orders" (upper right corner) to see the Your Orders page. Select "Enter Access Code".




5. In the space provided, type your access code and select "Submit Access Code". NOTE: Once you have submitted your access code you will have ongoing access to your E-Unit. You will not need to re-enter your access code again.


Once your access code is accepted, go to [Your Orders](#) to access your PLT products.




CARBON & CLIMATE
