Step Up Efforts To Stop Invasive Plants.

- ✓ Locate, map, and control invasive plants in your area.
- ✓ Spot spray or mow invasive plants at the right times, using the most effective herbicide or technology.
- ✓ Ensure that all material and equipment brought on-site is weed free.
- ✓ Minimize disturbance to healthy vegetation and soils.
- ✓ Clean off mud, seed, or other plant parts from all equipment between jobs or infestations.
- ✓ Dispose of invasive plants at a landfill – do not compost.
- ✓ Use native species in all plantings, if possible.
