Re: Adopted Exempt Rules of the State Department of Natural Resources Relating to Aquatic Plant Management Permit Fees, *Minnesota Rules*, part 6280.0450; Revisor's File No. R-04212

Dear Librarian:

The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has adopted rules relating to Aquatic Plant Management Permit Fees in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 103G.615, subdivision 2. The rule was published in the December 2, 2013, State Register.

Minnesota Statutes, section 103G.615, subdivision 2, states that:

The fees must be set by rule, and section 16A.1283 does not apply, but the rule must not take effect until 45 legislative days after it has been reported to the legislature.

To satisfy that requirement and pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 3.195, subdivision 1(b), the DNR is submitting the enclosed two copies of the rule as filed with the secretary of state along with a copy of Commissioner Landwehr's Order Adopting Rules affixed.
