The department is using the good cause exemption process under Minnesota Statutes, section 14.388, subd. 1, clause (4), to make changes that do not alter the sense, meaning, or effect of the rule.

This rulemaking makes a technical change to update the definition of "River Corridor Boundary" in Minnesota Rules, part 6106.0050, subpart 64, for the Mississippi River Corridor Critical Area rule that took effect on 4 January 2017. The DNR recently identified minor technical errors in the original legal description created by Executive Order 79-19 and published in the State Register on 3/12/1979 (Volume 3, pages 1681 – 1691). The DNR published a complete corrected legal description in the 11/05/2018 State Register (43 SR 508). The sole purpose of this rulemaking is to update the rule to reference the corrected November 2018 legal description publication instead of the incorrect 1979 publication.
