<i>Sparganium fluctuans</i>	Wide Floatingleaf Burreed

Emergent Plants (Plants with leaves extending above the water surface)

<i>Dulichium arundinaceum</i>	Three-way sedge
<i>Glyceria borealis</i>	Northern manna grass
<i>Sagittaria cristata</i>	Crested arrowhead
<i>Sagittaria latifolia</i>	Broad-leaved Arrowhead
<i>Typha</i> sp.	Cat-Tail

Shoreline Plants (Plants associated with the wetland habitat)

<i>Cicuta bulbifera</i>	Bulb-bearing water-hemlock
<i>Eleocharis acicularis</i>	Needle Spike-rush
<i>Eupatorium perfoliatum</i>	Common boneset
<i>Hypericum majus</i>	St. John's-wort
* <i>Juncus brevicaudatus</i>	Narrow-panicked rush
* <i>Juncus canadensis</i>	Canada rush
<i>Juncus pelocarpus</i>	Mud-fruit Rush
<i>Leersia oryzoides</i>	Rice cut grass
<i>Persicaria</i> sp.	Smartweed
<i>Phalaris arundinacea</i>	Reed canary grass
<i>Scirpus cyperinus</i>	Wool-grass
