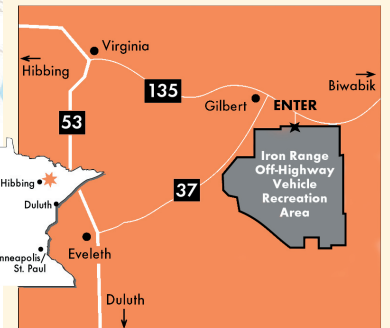
Welcome to the Iron Range Off-Highway Vehicle Recreation Area

This map will help you decide what areas to enjoy. The site is designed for families, and individuals of all ages and skills who ride all-terrain vehicles, off-highway motorcycles and 4x4 Jeeps and trucks. There is no charge for vehicles with a valid Minnesota off-highway vehicle registration. Vehicles entering the recreation area must meet state sound standards and riders need required safety equipment.

Trail conditions can change, so watch for trail closings or reroutes and follow signs to get you on your way. The Recreation Area closes one hour before sunset. Take note the closing times at the office where you received your daily use permit. Permits are collected at the end of each day to tally visitor use. We appreciate your help!

Directions from Minneapolis/St. Paul:
Go north on I-35 to Cloquet. Take Hwy. 33 north through Cloquet and join Hwy. 53 north to Eveleth. Turn east on Hwy. 37 to Gilbert. Turn east on Hwy. 135 and enter site on Enterprise Trail.
