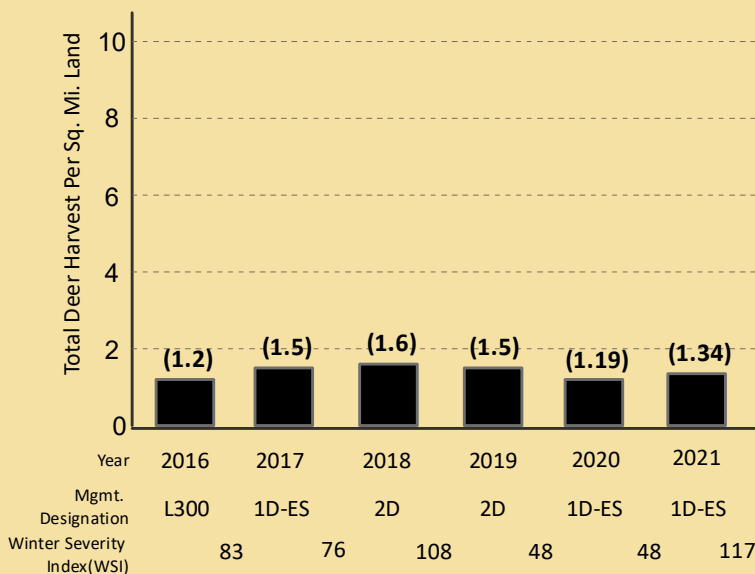

## Wildlife Manager Report

DPA 101 includes portions of eastern Marshall County, northwestern Beltrami County and southeastern Roseau County, and includes a substantial amount of publicly accessible lands. Deer populations in the DPA have grown in recent years under conservative regulations. A two-deer limit will allow additional harvest opportunities for hunters, especially in the western portion of the DPA where densities are higher. Discussing a boundary change for this DPA is recommended at the midpoint review of the deer goal setting process. This will help address the differences in habitat and deer populations within the current boundary.

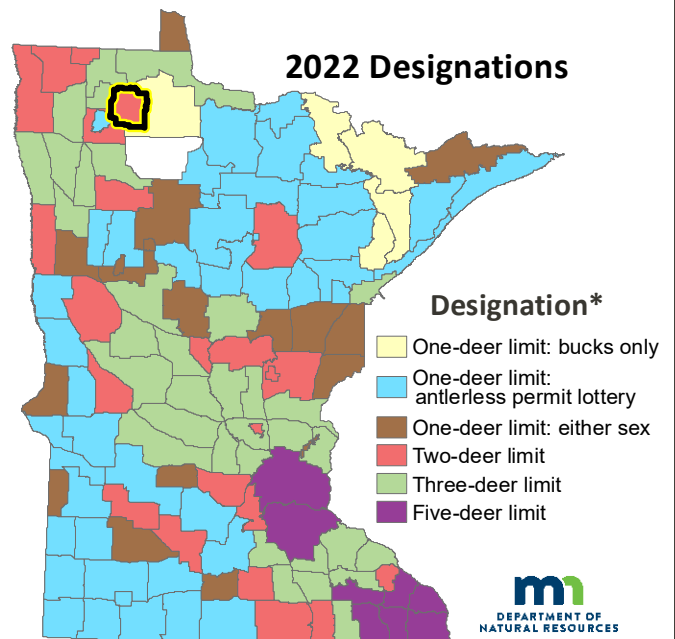
