Wildlife Manager Report

Deer Permit Area (DPA) 101 includes portions of eastern Marshall, northwestern Beltrami, southeast Roseau and a small portion of SW Lake of the Woods Counties. It includes a substantial amount of publicly accessible lands. Two consecutive winters (2021-22 and 2022-23) with deep snow well into April reduced deer densities, specifically in the eastern portion of the DPA. Another year of Either-Sex regulations, along with the mild 2024-25 winter, will increase this population and help maintain current success rates and buck harvest. Several boundary change options were presented to hunters in DPA 101 during the spring of 2025. The proposed boundaries were an attempt to better align the permit area with landscape and deer population factors. The results from the survey indicated that 75% of hunters preferred the current boundary and did not want to see it changed.

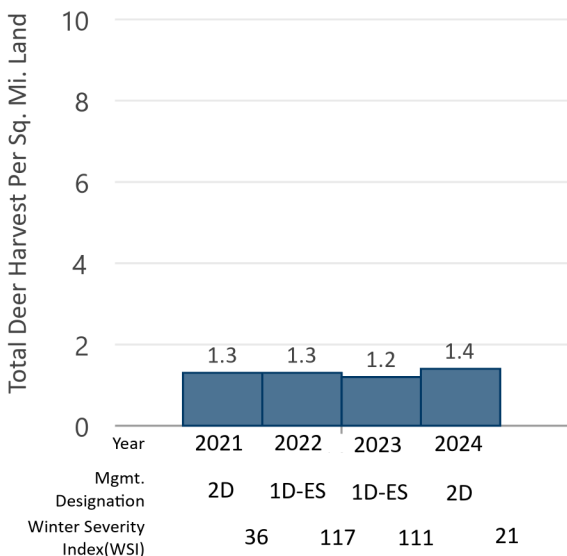
