Wildlife Manager Report

Deer Permit Area (DPA) 105 includes the northeastern portion of Roseau, the northern third of Lake of the Woods, and the northwest corner of Koochiching Counties. It extends from Roseau east to the Black River at Loman south to the northern portions of the Pine Island and Beltrami Island State Forests. The area is agricultural interspersed with aspen forest and brush lands. The population is currently estimated to be slightly below the goal established during the 2019-2020 public goal setting process. Despite this, there are also agricultural concerns about deer numbers in this permit area. The 2-deer limit management designation should maintain a stable population or allow the population to grow slightly.

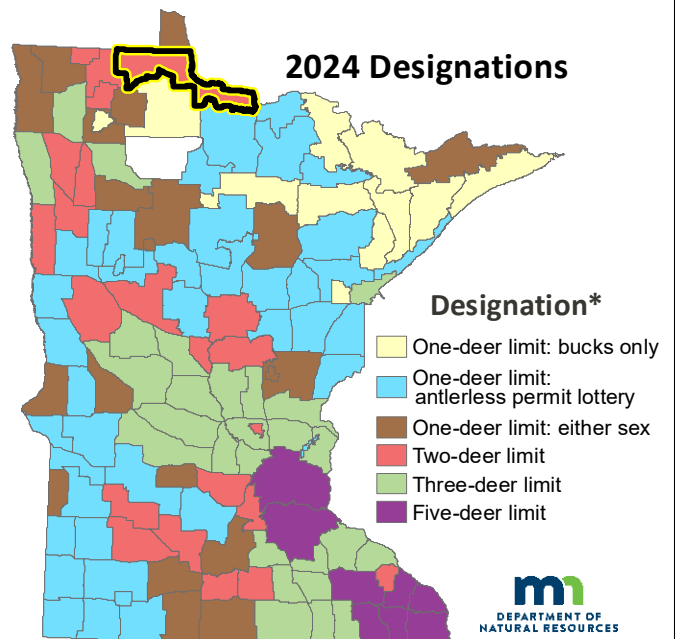
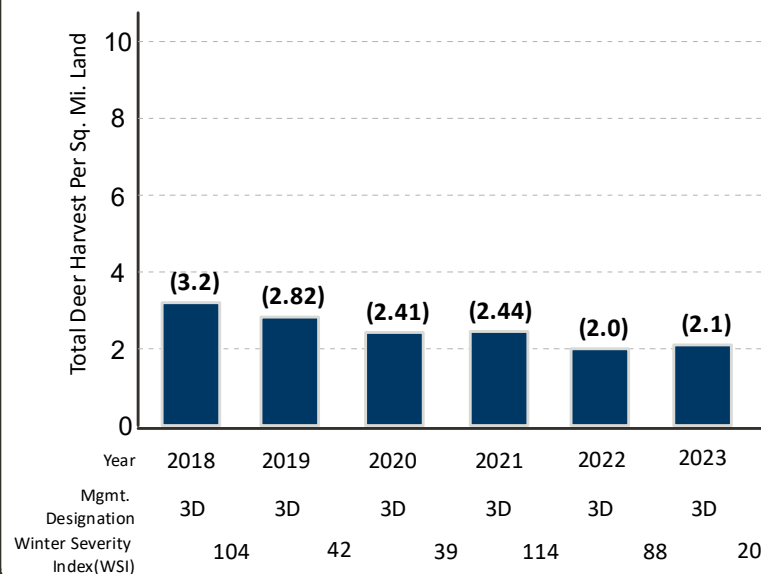
