#### Wildlife Manager Report

Deer Permit Area (DPA) 111 includes southern Lake of the Woods, the northern 1/4 of Beltrami, and a small portion of southeastern Marshall and Roseau Counties. The vast majority of this area is the Beltrami Island State Forest and Red Lake Wildlife Management Area, although there is some agriculture on the perimeter. The deer population in DPA 111 is currently estimated to be below the goal established during the 2020 public goal setting process. In the recent past, lottery designations have been unsuccessful at increasing the herd size, so a Bucks-only designation was implemented in 2023 to increase the population size. A mild 2023/2024 winter season combined with another season of a Bucks-only designation is anticipated to increase the herd size.
