Wildlife Manager Report

Deer Permit Area (DPA) 169 had a boundary change in 2021 to better match areas of current deer numbers. The permit area goal is to increase the deer population by 50%. Progress to increase deer numbers has been challenging because of a string of past severe winters and predator pressures. Areas of extensive public land presently have very few deer despite interspersed pockets of private land where deer numbers are higher. Deer numbers are still not increasing even with past reductions of antlerless permits, therefore a more conservative harvest strategy of Bucks-only is needed.
