Deer Permit Area (DPA) 178 lies south of the Iron Range, partially within the Superior National Forest in St. Louis, and a small portion of Itasca County. It has a mix of public and private lands. It is outside the primary moose range. DPA 178 is a mix of forest, agricultural fields, bogs and minelands. The local deer herd is currently below established population goals set in 2020. Implementation of a low Lottery management strategy will continue in 2024 to move the population towards goal.
