

Wildlife Manager Report

Deer Permit Area (DPA) 219 includes much of western Wright County and the very southeastern portion of Stearns County with a small portion of far eastern Meeker County. This area is interspersed habitats of rolling scattered hardwood forest mixed with agricultural cropland. Two major rivers (North Fork Crow River and Clearwater River) run through this area along with numerous shallow lakes. Deer populations in DPA 219 are currently well above goals established in the public goal setting process, and consecutive mild winters have led to increased herd growth. Utilizing a 3-Deer limit with an Early Antlerless season is anticipated to stabilize deer populations and potentially work towards the 25% population reduction goal, while providing hunters with tools to manage their local deer herds.
