Wildlife Manager Report

Deer Permit Area (DPA) 237 had a boundary change in 2021 shrinking it by approximately 122 square miles. 82% of this permit area consists of row crop agriculture. In 2016-2020 50 antlerless permits were allocated to increase the deer population. In order to stabilize an increasing deer population, the antlerless permit allocation was set at 200 from 2021-2023 and reduced to 75 in 2024. Due to harvest data trends, we will be setting the antlerless permit allocation at 100 in 2025. This strategy will be re-evaluated after the 2025 harvest data is in and adjust accordingly.

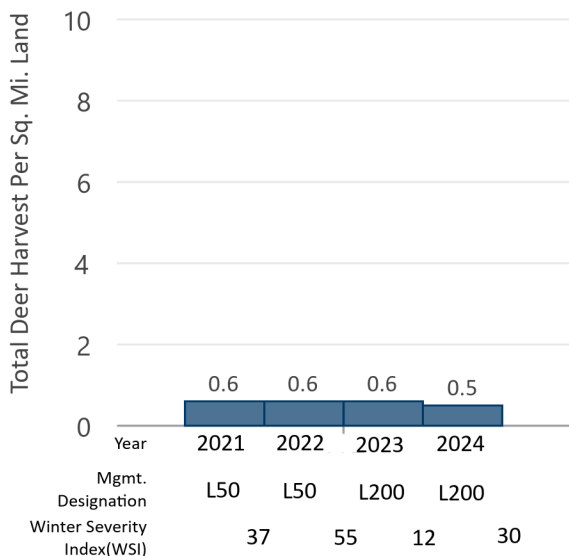

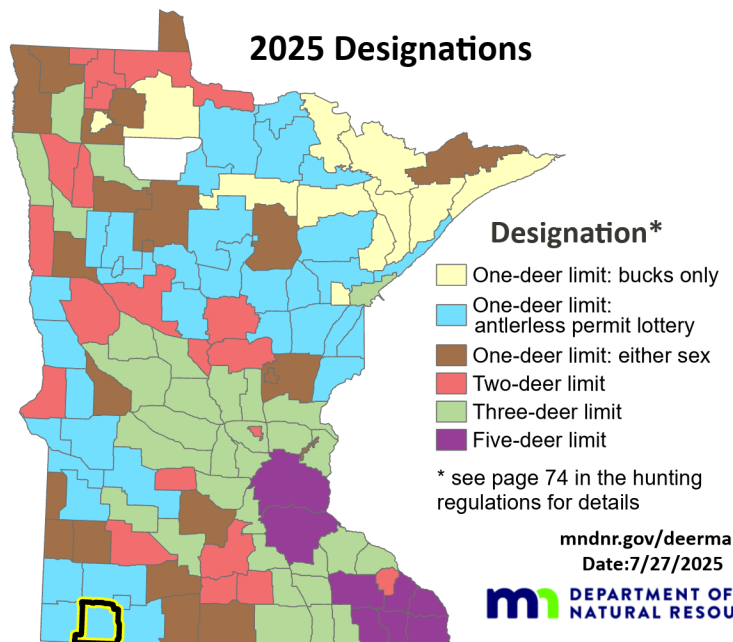
