Wildlife Manager Report

Deer Permit Area (DPA) 238 is a small permit area surrounding the 5000+ acre Talcot Lake Wildlife Management Area. The harvest strategy for a number of years allocated 50 antlerless permits. Due to this strategy the deer population increased, and antlerless permits were increased incrementally since 2021 to stabilize the population. In 2023, 125 antlerless permits were offered. Due to harvest data trends and new fawn survival data, we will be offering 50 antlerless permits again in 2025 to increase the population. When the 2025 harvest data is in, we will re-evaluate this strategy and adjust accordingly in 2026.

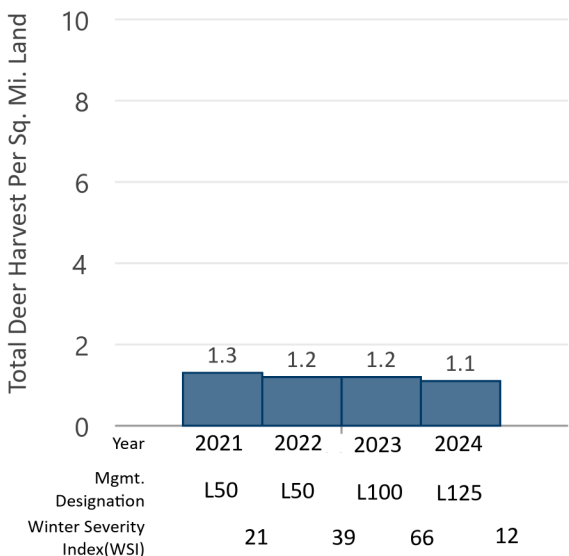
