

Waters seasonally closed to taking fish. Spring 2018. April 19, 2018

The following waters in the portions designated are closed to the taking of all fish during the periods specified to protect fish spawning areas. Look for signs at access sites and in the areas as noted. All dates are inclusive.

Additional closures or openings may be posted to this site up to 48 hours prior to the law taking effect. U FN = until further notice. End date to be determined based on the status of walleye spawning.

Maligne River (also known as Northern Light Rapids)	on the Ontario side of Saganaga Lake	Cook	April 1 May 31
Saganaga Falls	on the Minnesota-Ontario border where the Granite River enters Saganaga Lake	Cook	April 1 – May 31
Tait River	White Pine Lake to Forest Rd. 340 crossing, including a portion of White Pine Lake	Cook	May 12 – May 25
Unnamed channel	between Little Gunflint and Little North Lakes on the Minnesota-Ontario border	Cook	April 1 – May 31
