

## NATIONAL FLOOD INSURANCE PROGRAM (NFIP) APPLICATION PACKAGE FOR THE STATE OF MINNESOTA

In order to join the NFIP, your community must submit the following information:

- 1. A completed copy of the attached NFIP application requesting information such as community address, population information, flood map repository location, etc.
- 2. A certified copy of an adopted resolution of intent to participate in the NFIP. A model resolution is attached.
- 3. A certified copy of an adopted ordinance that is compliant with Federal and State standards required for participation in the NFIP.

\*\* Note that state law requires DNR to approve the draft ordinance before it is adopted. Also note that a hearing notice must run in the newspaper at least 10 days before the hearing, and the ordinance (or amendment) does not become effective until that ordinance (or amendment), or a summary of the ordinance (or amendment), runs in the newspaper.

For communities that do not have a map of flood hazard areas (prepared by FEMA), a model ordinance is attached. For communities with a map of flood hazard areas (prepared by FEMA), Minnesota DNR Waters has prepared several model ordinances depending on the type of maps your community has.
