Meeting Notes

On a 100' lot you can have 2 docks? Why doesn't DNR regulate the amount of docks you can have on a lot?

Limit the dimension for a concrete dock to 8 feet from the OHW.

On Lake Vermilion there is every dock imaginable. Is there going to be any grandfathering in?

What is being done to communicate to others in areas that are not having these meetings?

Removable docks over 8 feet – once they are taken out can they be put back in?

Will the rules cover resorts? Do they have their own guidelines?

When a customer buys a dock bigger than 8 feet does the dock manufacturer have a liability?

DNR has to be specific on this issue!

In the Lake Vermilion area there are one-piece unit docks. The majority are 8 feet and under (steel frame, lift out).

There are more platform type docks on Lake Vermilion because they do not need much access out to the lake.

Are there rules for commercial marinas?

Do floating platforms and water trampolines need to comply with the 8 foot rule?

Crib docks – if you don't have one can you build one?

Long docks installed for backlot access. How long is too long?

Is a structure (not considered a dock) to access an island 30 feet from the shoreline regulated?

How is a dock that encroaches onto the neighbor's property regulated?
