**6266.0400 TAKING OF FISH ON MINNESOTA-SOUTH DAKOTA BOUNDARY WATERS.**

**Subp. 2. Species, seasons, and limits on Minnesota-South Dakota boundary waters.** Except as provided in part 6264.0400, subpart 29, the following applies to the species, seasons, and limits for taking fish on Minnesota-South Dakota boundary waters:

Species	Open Season	Daily and Possession Limits
A. Walleye and sauger	<del>Last Saturday in April</del> <u>closest to April 21</u> through last day in February.	6 <i>Correct limit is 4, see note, below, for explanation.</i>
B. Northern pike	<del>Last Saturday in April</del> <u>closest to April 21</u> through last day in February.	6
C. Small and large mouth bass	<del>Last Saturday in April</del> <u>closest to April 21</u> through last day in February.	6

**Walleye limit note:** *The limit of “6” listed above is superceded by the limit of “4” listed in MR 6264.0400, subp. 29 (see “Except as provided in part 6240.0400, subpart 29 ....” note included in the text of the rule, above). The special management/experimental regulations in rule Chapter 6264 control over the regulations listed in the boundary waters section, above. Our authority for emergency rules allows only changing the season, and this rule could not technically include the “4” limit. The fishing regulations booklets have and do correctly list “4”, and the new permanent rule package that is in process will also list “4”.*
