1.8 Subp. 5. **Deer taken in the special bovine tuberculosis area.** Deer taken in the
1.9 special bovine tuberculosis area (deer area 101) must be registered prior to transport
1.10 outside the area, except that deer may be registered in Wannaska or at the Department
1.11 of Natural Resources Office at Thief Lake or Red Lake.

1.12 **6232.0800 ARCHERY SPECIAL HUNT AREAS AND PROCEDURES.**

1.13 [For text of subp 1, see M.R.]

1.14 Subp. 1a. 2008-2009 archery special hunt area. Deer area 101, as described in
1.15 part 6232.4700, subpart 1a, is open December 27, 2008, to January 11, 2009, for taking
1.16 antlerless deer and legal bucks. All hunters possessing a valid 2008 Minnesota deer
1.17 archery license may participate and deer may be tagged using that license or any permit
1.18 type. Hunters hunting in deer area 101 during this special hunt may take and tag an
1.19 unlimited number of deer. Deer taken during this special hunt must be registered at one of
1.20 the following registration stations: Olson Skime Store in Skime, the Riverfront Store in
1.21 Wannaska, or the Department of Natural Resources Office at Thief Lake or Red Lake.

1.23 **6232.1600 SPECIAL HUNT PROCEDURES.**

2.1 Subp. 5a. 2008-2009 firearms special hunt area. Deer area 101, as described in
2.2 part 6232.4700, subpart 1a, is open December 27, 2008, to January 11, 2009, for taking
2.3 antlerless deer and legal bucks. All hunters possessing a valid 2008 Minnesota regular
2.4 deer firearm or muzzleloader license may participate and deer may be tagged using a
2.5 firearm or muzzleloader license or any permit type. Hunters hunting in deer area 101
2.6 during this special hunt may take and tag an unlimited number of deer with any legal
2.7 firearm or muzzleloader. Deer taken during this special hunt must be registered at one of
2.8 the following registration stations: Olson Skime Store in Skime, the Riverfront Store in
2.9 Wannaska, or the Department of Natural Resources Office at Thief Lake or Red Lake.

2.11 **REPEALER.** The expedited emergency amendment to Minnesota Rules, part 6232.0400,
2.12 subpart 5, published in the State Register, volume 33, page 363, August 25, 2008, is
2.13 repealed.

2.14 **EFFECTIVE PERIOD.** The expedited emergency amendments to Minnesota
2.15 Rules, parts 6232.0400, 6232.0800, and 6232.1600, expire February 28, 2009. After
2.16 the emergency amendments expire, the permanent rules as they read prior to these
2.17 amendments again take effect, except as they may be amended by permanent rule.
