1.2 **Adopted Expedited Emergency Game and Fish Rules: 2009 Camp Ripley Archery**  
1.3 **Deer Hunt; 2009 Youth Deer Hunts and Seasons**

1.4 **6232.0900 CAMP RIPLEY ARCHERY HUNT.**

1.5 [For text of subps 1 and 2, see M.R.]

1.6 Subp. 3. **Antlerless deer and legal bucks.** In 2009, Camp Ripley is open for taking  
1.7 antlerless deer and legal bucks. Not more than 2,500 permits shall be issued for each  
1.8 two-day hunting period.

1.9 Subp. 4. **Bag limits.** The bag limit for the Camp Ripley archery hunt is two deer.  
1.10 Hunters may use bonus permits to take antlerless deer and may take a deer of either sex on  
1.11 a regular license. Only one legal buck may be taken during this hunt.

1.12 **6232.1100 SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS FOR CAMP RIPLEY ARCHERY HUNT.**

1.13 Subpart 1. **Access to Camp Ripley.** This subpart applies to access into Camp Ripley  
1.14 during the archery hunt.

1.15 A. Archers with valid permits must enter and leave Camp Ripley only by way  
1.16 of the southeast railroad gate and only from ~~noon~~ 5:00 a.m. on the day before the hunt  
1.17 to 8:00 p.m. on the last day of the hunt.

5.1 **6232.2560 YOUTH SPECIAL DEER SEASONS.**

5.2 Subpart 1. Season requirements. Youths participating in youth special deer seasons  
5.3 must obtain a license for taking deer by firearms, valid for any season option, by the  
5.4 beginning date of the special season. A youth special season participant may take one deer,  
5.5 which must be antlerless. One bonus permit may be used. An adult mentor age 18 or older  
5.6 authorized by the youth's parent or guardian must accompany the youth hunter at all times  
5.7 during the hunt. The accompanying adult may not hunt. Party hunting is not allowed. The  
5.8 blaze orange requirements in Minnesota Statutes, section 97B.071, paragraph (a), apply  
5.9 to all hunters and trappers, and all adult mentors of youth hunters, in the areas open to  
5.10 firearms deer hunting during the youth special seasons established in this part.

5.11 Subp. 2. Open areas. Open areas and dates for youth special deer seasons shall  
5.12 be established annually by the commissioner. For 2009, Kittson, Lake of the Woods,  
5.13 Marshall, Pennington, and Roseau Counties are open October 17 and 18 for taking  
5.14 antlerless deer by firearms for youth who are at least age 12 and under age 15 at the time  
5.15 of the hunt. Old Mill State Park, Lake Bronson State Park, Hayes Lake State Park, and  
5.16 Zippel Bay State Park are open to taking antlerless deer by eligible youth during the  
5.17 2009 youth special deer season. One bonus permit may be used, but a hunter may not  
5.18 take more than one deer.

5.19 EFFECTIVE PERIOD. The emergency amendments to Minnesota Rules, parts  
5.20 6232.0900, 6232.1100, 6232.2550, and 6232.2560, expire December 31, 2009. After  
5.21 the emergency amendments expire, the permanent rules as they read prior to those  
5.22 amendments again take effect, except as they may be amended by permanent rule.
