1.2 **Adopted Expedited Emergency Game and Fish Rules: Waterfowl Hunting**

1.3 **6240.0650 TAKING COOTS, MOORHENS, AND DUCKS.**

1.4 Subpart 1. **Open season.** Coots, moorhens, and ducks may be taken statewide during
1.5 the 60-day period from October 3 to December 1, 2009.

1.6 Subp. 2. **Daily limits.** In any one day, a person may not take more than six ducks,
1.7 five mergansers, and a total of 15 coots and moorhens. The daily limit of ducks other than
1.8 mergansers may not include more than four mallards, including one female mallard; two
1.9 redheads; two scaup; two wood ducks; one black duck; one canvasback; and one pintail.
1.10 The daily limit of mergansers may not include more than two hooded mergansers.

1.11 **6240.0950 OPEN SEASONS; DAILY LIMIT; WEST AND WEST CENTRAL**
1.12 **GOOSE ZONES.**

1.13 Subpart 1. **Open season; West Goose Zone.** Canada geese may be taken in the West
1.14 Goose Zone during the 60-day period from October 3 to December 1, 2009, except in the
1.15 West Central Goose Zone as provided in subpart 2.

1.16 Subp. 2. **Open season; West Central Goose Zone.** Canada geese may be taken in
1.17 the West Central Goose Zone during the 41-day period from October 15 to October 18,
1.18 2009, and October 24 to November 29, 2009.

1.19 Subp. 3. **Daily limit.** A person may not take more than two Canada geese in the West
1.20 and West Central Goose Zones.

1.21 **EFFECTIVE PERIOD.** Minnesota Rules, parts 6240.0650 and 6240.0950, expire
1.22 January 1, 2010.
