1.20 Subp. 63. LaSalle State Recreation Area, Hubbard County. The LaSalle State  
 1.21 Recreation Area in Hubbard County is open to:

- 1.22 A. deer and bear hunting by firearms;
- 1.23 B. deer and bear hunting by archery;

2.1 C. small game hunting and trapping during designated seasons for protected  
2.2 species;

2.3 D. use of hunting dogs during hunting seasons for protected species when  
2.4 accompanied by or under control of the owner; and

2.5 E. fishing.

2.6 **EFFECTIVE PERIOD.** The emergency amendment to Minnesota Rules, part  
2.7 6230.0400, is effective retroactively from November 5, 2011. The emergency amendment  
2.8 to Minnesota Rules, part 6230.0400, expires January 1, 2013. After the emergency  
2.9 amendment expires, the permanent rule as it read prior to that amendment again takes  
2.10 effect, except as it may be amended by permanent rule.
