 1.2 **Adopted Expedited Emergency Game and Fish Rules: Spring Turkey Hunt**

1.3 **6236.0300 TURKEY HUNT DRAWING.**

1.4 [For text of subp 1, see M.R.]

1.5 Subp. 2. **Participation in application drawings.** Applicants may complete an
 1.6 application for either the spring or fall turkey hunt or both. A person may not apply more
 1.7 than once for a hunt, whether as an individual or as a member of a group. Qualifying
 1.8 individuals may apply for the resident landowner-tenant turkey drawing. All of the
 1.9 information in items A to ~~G~~H must be supplied on the application forms.

1.10 [For text of items A to C, see M.R.]

1.11 ~~D. An applicant must select a first choice of wild turkey permit area and time~~
 1.12 ~~period and may select a second choice of wild turkey permit area in specified time periods~~
 1.13 ~~as authorized by the commissioner.~~

1.14 E D. Up to four persons desiring to hunt together as a group may apply as a
 1.15 group. Group applications shall either all be selected or none selected. All group members
 1.16 must apply for the same wild turkey permit areas and time periods. The preference rating
 1.17 of applicants who apply as a group shall be determined by the individual in the group
 1.18 with the lowest preference. Group applications may be made up of all general or all
 1.19 landowner-tenant applications, but not both.

1.20 F E. A person who applies as a landowner or tenant but does not meet the
 1.21 definition as provided by this part will be ineligible for that season's drawings.

1.22 G F. Application deadlines are as follows:

1.23 (1) spring season: ~~the first Friday in December~~ second Friday in January;

1.24 and

1.25 (2) fall season: the last Friday in July.

2.1 G. A person who has not purchased a 2011 spring turkey license for seasons A
2.2 to F may purchase a turkey hunting license to hunt the spring turkey season during either
2.3 the seventh time period May 13-19 or the eighth time period May 20-26.

2.4 (1) A turkey hunting license under this item may be purchased directly
2.5 from an ELS vendor and is separate from the lottery process.

2.6 (2) Turkey lottery preference points shall not be reduced for a person
2.7 purchasing a license under this item.

2.8 H. Youth age 17 and younger may purchase a turkey hunting license to hunt one
2.9 of the eight spring turkey seasons. A turkey hunting license under this item is separate
2.10 from the normal lottery process and is effective for hunting only in wild turkey permit
2.11 areas during an established time period. The youth hunter must select a permit area.

2.13 **6236.0810 WILD TURKEY PERMIT AREA DESCRIPTIONS.**

2.14 Wild turkey permit areas are comprised of registration blocks with the same numbers,
2.15 as established in part 6232.4700, except as follows:

2.16 A. wild turkey permit area 425 consists of registration blocks ~~425~~ 282 and
2.17 ~~435~~ 281;

2.18 B. wild turkey permit area 451 consists of registration blocks ~~451~~ 234, ~~452~~ 237,
2.19 and ~~453~~ 294; and

2.20 C. wild turkey permit area 454 consists of registration blocks ~~454~~ 238 and
2.21 ~~455~~ 295; and

2.22 D. permit areas 230 to 233, 237, 250 to 255, and 269 to 299 shall be identified
2.23 in application materials and on electronically issued licenses by the three-digit number
2.24 that appears in parenthesis following the permit area number under part 6236.1060.
