1.2 **Adopted Expedited Emergency Game and Fish Rules: Special Spring Turkey Hunts**

1.3 **6230.0200 SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREAS.**

1.4 [For text of subps 1 to 11, see M.R.]

1.5 Subp. 12. **Sanctuary areas open to hunting.** The following sanctuary areas of
1.6 wildlife management areas posted with "Wildlife Sanctuary Do Not Trespass" signs are
1.7 open for hunting as specified:

1.8 A. The Talcot Lake Wildlife Management Area Sanctuary is open for deer
1.9 hunting by persons with disabilities at designated stands, by permit, during the established
1.10 state seasons.

1.11 B. Those portions of the Carlos Avery Wildlife Management Area sanctuaries
1.12 lying either east of the Old Game Farm Road or north of Anoka County Ditch 12 are
1.13 open for:

1.14 (1) deer hunting by persons with disabilities at designated stands, by
1.15 permit, and or blinds during a special hunt sponsored by a nonprofit organization;

1.16 (2) taking wild turkeys during the spring wild turkey season in those
1.17 portions of the sanctuaries that lie within an open spring wild turkey hunting zone;

1.18 (3) waterfowl hunting with a special permit during open waterfowl seasons
1.19 in designated blinds; and

1.20 (4) wild turkey and waterfowl hunting by disabled persons at designated
1.21 stands or blinds, coordinated through an approved and permitted nonprofit organization.

2.1 **6236.1060 WILD TURKEY DISABILITY HUNTS.**

2.2 For the 2014 spring wild turkey season, the following permits are available for
2.3 disability hunts.

2.4 A. For wild turkey permit area 507, one additional permit per time periods A
2.5 to C are available for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt on the
2.6 Sand Prairie Wildlife Management Area. Midwest Outdoors Unlimited is the sponsoring
2.7 nonprofit organization.

2.8 B. Camp Ripley Military Reservation, within wild turkey permit area 507, is
2.9 open for spring turkey hunting for individuals with disabilities participating in a special
2.10 hunt. One nonhunting mentor must accompany each disabled hunter. The St. Cloud
2.11 Veterans Administration is the sponsoring organization.

2.12 C. For wild turkey permit area 507, two additional permits are available for
2.13 both time periods A and C for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt
2.14 at the Prairie Woods Environmental Learning Center. Midwest Outdoors Unlimited and
2.15 Prairie Woods Environmental Learning Center are the sponsoring nonprofit organizations.

2.16 D. For wild turkey permit area 507, four additional permits for each of time
2.17 periods A to C are available to individuals participating in a special hunt. Midwest
2.18 Outdoors Unlimited is the sponsoring nonprofit organization.

2.19 E. For wild turkey permit area 508, two additional permits for both time periods
2.20 A and C are available for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt in
2.21 Benton County Bend in the River Park. Midwest Outdoors Unlimited is the sponsoring
2.22 nonprofit organization.

2.23 F. For wild turkey permit area 507, two additional permits for both time
2.24 periods A and B are available for individuals with disabilities participating in a special
2.25 hunt in Rockville County Park. Midwest Outdoors Unlimited is the sponsoring nonprofit
2.26 organization.

3.1 G. For wild turkey permit area 506, one additional permit for both time periods
3.2 A and C are available for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt in
3.3 the Orwell Dam State Wildlife Management Area. Midwest Outdoors Unlimited is the
3.4 sponsoring nonprofit organization.

3.5 **6236.1075 WILD TURKEY SPECIAL HUNTS FOR MILITARY PERSONNEL.**

3.6 For the 2014 spring wild turkey season, the following permits are available for
3.7 special hunts for military personnel.

3.8 A. Camp Ripley Military Reservation is open to spring wild turkey hunting with
3.9 an unlimited number of permits.

3.10 B. For Arden Hills Army Training Site, within wild turkey permit area 510, up
3.11 to 20 additional permits shall be issued for both time periods A and C. The Department of
3.12 Military Affairs is the sponsoring organization.

3.13 **EXPIRATION.** The expedited emergency amendments to Minnesota Rules, part
3.14 6230.0200, subdivision 12, expire December 31, 2014. Minnesota Rules, parts 6236.1060
3.15 and 6236.1075, expire July 1, 2014.
