6236.0300 TURKEY HUNT DRAWING.

1.4 Subpart 1. Spring license application drawings.

A. Applications for all spring hunts must be made according to this part and 1.5 according to application instructions provided by the commissioner. Each person must 1.6 apply at an electronic license system agent or the Department of Natural Resources 1.7 License Center. Drawings will be conducted by the department to determine persons who 1.8 will be eligible to purchase licenses for each season. The drawings will be subject to the 1.9 quotas established by the commissioner. Preference in the respective drawings is given 1.10 to applicants based upon the number of times they have correctly applied for a license 1.11 for that hunt but have been unsuccessful. A person selected by the drawings is eligible to 1.12 purchase a license to hunt turkey. Upon issuance of a turkey license for the spring or fall 1.13 season, all accumulated preference for that season is lost, except as provided in subpart 6. 1.14

B. No application is needed to purchase a fall turkey license.

Subp. 2. Participation in application drawings. Applicants may complete an
application for either the spring or fall turkey hunt or both. A person may not apply more
than once for a hunt, whether as an individual or as a member of a group. Qualifying
individuals may apply for the resident landowner-tenant turkey drawing. All of the
information in items A to H must be supplied on the application forms.
