1.2 **Adopted Expedited Emergency Game and Fish Rules: 2014 Camp Ripley Archery**  
 1.3 **Deer Hunt Quota; 2014 Prairie Chicken Hunting**

1.4 **6232.0900 CAMP RIPLEY ARCHERY HUNT.**

1.5 Subpart 1. **Deer season and hunter quota.** Camp Ripley may be open, by permit  
 1.6 only, for the taking of deer by archery. Open dates are ~~the two-day period beginning the~~  
 1.7 ~~third Thursday in October~~ 15 and 16 and the two-day period beginning the last Saturday in  
 1.8 October.

1.10 Subp. 3. **Antlerless deer and legal bucks.** In 2014, Camp Ripley is open for taking  
 1.11 antlerless deer and legal bucks. No more than 2,000 permits shall be issued for each  
 1.12 two-day hunting period.

1.13 Subp. 4. **Bag limits.** The bag limit for the Camp Ripley archery hunt is one deer.  
 1.14 Hunters may use bonus permits to take antlerless deer or may take a deer of either sex  
 1.15 on a regular license.

1.23 Subpart 1. **Open season and methods.** Prairie chickens may be taken during the  
 1.24 ~~five-day~~ nine-day period beginning on the last Saturday nearest October 20 ~~in September.~~

2.2 Subp. 4. **Open areas.** Prairie chicken permit areas are open for the prairie chicken  
 2.3 season as prescribed by the commissioner. Prairie chicken licenses are valid only in the  
 2.4 prairie chicken permit area specified on the license. The following prairie chicken permit  
 2.5 areas, as described in part 6237.0550, are open with prescribed quotas for the 2014 season:

2.23 Subp. 2. [See repealer.]

2.24 Subp. 3. **Area 803A.** Prairie chicken permit area 803A consists of that portion of  
 2.25 the state lying within the following described boundary:

2.26 Beginning at the intersection of United States Highway (U.S.) 59 and State Trunk  
 2.27 Highway (STH) 32; thence along U.S. 59 to U.S. 2; thence along U.S. 2 to STH 32;

3.1 ~~thence along STH 32 and Pennington County State-Aid Highway (CSAH) 3; thence~~  
3.2 ~~along U.S. 59 to U.S. 2; thence along U.S. 2 to U.S. 75; thence along U.S. 75 to~~  
3.3 ~~Polk CSAH 21; thence along Polk CSAH 21 to Pennington CSAH 3; thence along~~  
3.4 ~~Pennington CSAH 3 to the point of beginning.~~

3.6 Subp. 12. **Area 812A.** Prairie chicken permit area 812A consists of that portion of  
3.7 the state lying within the following described boundary:

3.8 Beginning at the intersection of State Trunk Highway (STH) 32 and STH 113; thence  
3.9 along STH 113 to United States Highway (U.S.) 59; thence along U.S. 59 to U.S. 10;  
3.10 thence along U.S. 10 to STH 32; thence along STH 32 to the point of beginning.

3.11 Subp. 13. **Area 813A.** Prairie chicken permit area 813A consists of that portion of  
3.12 the state lying within the following described boundary:

3.13 Beginning at the intersection of State Trunk Highway (STH) 32 and Polk County  
3.14 State-Aid Highway (CSAH) 1; thence along CSAH 1 to United States Highway  
3.15 (U.S.) 59; thence along U.S. 59 to STH 113; thence along STH 113 to STH 32; thence  
3.16 along STH 32 to the point of beginning.

3.17 **REPEALER.** Minnesota Rules, part 6237.0550, subpart 2, is repealed.

3.18 **EFFECTIVE PERIOD.** The emergency amendments to Minnesota Rules, parts  
3.19 6232.0900, 6237.0200, 6237.0400, and 6237.0550, and the repealer expire December 31,  
3.20 2014. After the emergency amendments and repealer expire, the permanent rules as  
3.21 they read prior to those amendments or repealer again take effect, except as they may  
3.22 be amended by permanent rule.
