1.2 **Adopted Expedited Emergency Game and Fish Rules: Disabled Hunts and 2014**  
1.3 **Wolf Season**

1.4 **6232.2500 DISABLED HUNT.**

1.5 [For text of subp 1, see M.R.]

1.6 Subp. 2. **Open areas.** Disability permittees may hunt in open areas and seasons as  
1.7 designated by the commissioner and published in the annual hunting regulations booklet.  
1.8 In 2014, the following areas are open for hunting by disabled hunters:

1.9 [For text of items A to H, see 39 SR 158]

1.10 I. portions of Wasioja Township in Dodge County; Sumner and Fountain  
1.11 Townships in Fillmore County; Pleasant Valley and Sargeant Townships in Mower  
1.12 County; and High Forest Township in Olmsted County are open October 16 to 19 for  
1.13 taking antlerless deer and legal bucks using legal firearms. No more than 10 permits shall  
1.14 be issued. The bag limit is one either-sex deer. Special Youth Challenge of Minnesota  
1.15 is the sponsor; ~~and~~

1.16 J. portions of Carlos Avery Wildlife Management Area Sanctuary in Anoka  
1.17 County are open October 4 to 12 for taking antlerless deer and legal bucks using legal  
1.18 firearms or bows and arrows. No more than 30 permits shall be issued. The bag limit is  
1.19 two deer. Capable Partners is the sponsor; and

1.20 K. Township 57 North, Range 7 West, Section 33, Lake County, is open  
1.21 November 8 to 23 for taking either-sex deer using legal firearms. No more than two  
1.22 permits shall be issued. The bag limit is one either-sex deer. The Maritime Club of Silver  
1.23 Bay is the sponsor.

1.24 **6234.2105 TAKING WOLF.**

2.1 Subp. 4. **Application procedures for wolf license.**

2.2 [For text of items A to E, see 39 SR 234]

2.3 F. A person selected through the wolf license drawing must purchase the license  
2.4 no later than October ~~24~~ 31 if selected for the early season or November ~~14~~ 21 if selected  
2.5 for late season hunting or late season trapping. Any licenses not purchased by the deadline  
2.6 shall be issued according to item G.

2.7 G. Wolf licenses that are not purchased by the deadlines described in item F  
2.8 shall be offered for sale as follows:

2.9 (1) unsuccessful wolf license applicants may purchase unsold wolf licenses  
2.10 on a first-come, first-served basis beginning at 12:00 p.m. on ~~October 29~~ November 5 for  
2.11 the early season and beginning at 12:00 p.m. on November ~~19~~ 26 for late season hunting  
2.12 and late season trapping. An eligible person must apply individually and in person at an  
2.13 ELS-POS (point of sale) agent location or through the ELS-Internet system to obtain  
2.14 a remaining license; and

2.15 (2) any remaining available licenses not purchased by unsuccessful  
2.16 applicants may then be sold to any eligible person on a first-come, first-served basis  
2.17 beginning at 12:00 p.m. on November ~~5~~ 7 for the early season and beginning at 12:00  
2.18 p.m. on November ~~26~~ 28 for late season hunting and late season trapping. An individual  
2.19 may purchase one wolf license annually.

2.22 **EFFECTIVE PERIOD.** The expedited emergency amendment to Minnesota Rules, part  
2.23 6232.2500, subpart 2, expires December 31, 2014. The expedited emergency amendment  
2.24 to Minnesota Rules, part 6234.2105, subpart 4, expires February 1, 2015.
