1.3 **6230.0200 SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREAS.**

1.6 Subp. 12. **Sanctuary areas open.** The following sanctuary areas of wildlife
1.7 management areas posted with "Wildlife Sanctuary Do Not Trespass" signs are open as
1.8 specified:

1.10 B. The portions of the Carlos Avery Wildlife Management Area sanctuaries
1.11 lying east of the Old Game Farm Road and north of Anoka County Ditch 12 are open for:

1.12 (1) turkey, deer, or waterfowl hunting by persons with disabilities at
1.13 designated stands, by permit or blinds during a special hunt coordinated through an
1.14 approved and permitted nonprofit organization; and

1.15 (2) taking wild turkeys during the spring wild turkey season in those
1.16 portions of the sanctuaries that lie within an open spring wild turkey hunting zone.

1.17 The remainder of the sanctuaries are closed to all hunting and trespassing without
1.18 a permit.

1.23 Subp. 2. **Permit area 501.** Permit area 501 consists of that portion of the state lying
1.24 within the following described boundary:

2.1 Beginning at the intersection of the southern and eastern boundaries of the state;
 2.2 thence along the southern boundary to U.S. Highway 63, Fillmore County; thence
 2.3 along U.S. Highway 63 to State Trunk Highway (STH) 30, Olmsted County; thence
 2.4 along STH 30 to County State-Aid Highway (CSAH) 13, Olmsted County; thence
 2.5 along CSAH 13 to STH 57, Dodge County; thence along STH 57 to U.S. Highway
 2.6 52; thence along U.S. Highway 52 to STH 19; thence along STH 19 to the west bank
 2.7 of the Little Cannon River; thence along the west bank of the Little Cannon River
 2.8 to the north bank of the Cannon River; thence along the north bank of the Cannon
 2.9 River to U.S. Highway 61; thence along U.S. Highway 61 to ~~U.S. Highway 63~~;
 2.10 ~~thence along U.S. Highway 63 to~~ CSAH 18, Goodhue County; thence along CSAH
 2.11 18 to Lock and Dam No. 3 and the eastern boundary of the state; thence along the
 2.12 eastern boundary of the state to the point of beginning.

2.15 Subpart 1. 2015 open areas. The following wild turkey permit areas are open for the
 2.16 2015 spring wild turkey season with the quotas on numbers of permits for time periods A to
 2.17 C established below. An unlimited number of licenses are available for time periods D to H:

3.3 Subp. 2. **Permits for disability hunts.** For the 2015 spring wild turkey season, the
 3.4 following permits are available for disability hunts:

3.5 A. For wild turkey permit area 507, one additional permit per time periods A to C
 3.6 is available for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt in the Sand Prairie
 3.7 Wildlife Management Area. Capable Partners is the sponsoring nonprofit organization.

3.8 B. For wild turkey permit area 510, four additional permits per time periods A
 3.9 to C are available for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt in the
 3.10 Becklin Homestead Park Wildlife Management Area. Capable Partners and the Isanti
 3.11 County Sportsman's Club are the sponsoring nonprofit organizations.

3.12 C. Camp Ripley Military Reservation, within wild turkey permit area 507, is
 3.13 open for spring turkey hunting for individuals with disabilities participating in a special
 3.14 hunt. One nonhunting mentor must accompany each disabled hunter. The St. Cloud
 3.15 Veterans Administration is the sponsoring organization.

3.16 D. For wild turkey permit area 507, two additional permits are available for
 3.17 both time periods A and C for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt
 3.18 at the Prairie Woods Environmental Learning Center. Midwest Outdoors Unlimited and
 3.19 Prairie Woods Environmental Learning Center are the sponsoring nonprofit organizations.

3.20 E. For wild turkey permit area 505, two additional permits per time periods A
 3.21 to C are available for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt in the
 3.22 Minnesota Valley National Wildlife Refuge. Capable Partners is the sponsoring nonprofit
 3.23 organization.

4.1 F. For wild turkey permit area 507, four additional permits per time periods A to
4.2 C are available for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt. Midwest
4.3 Outdoors Unlimited is the sponsoring nonprofit organization.

4.4 G. For wild turkey permit area 508, two additional permits per time periods A
4.5 and C are available for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt in the
4.6 Benton County Bend in the River Park. Midwest Outdoors Unlimited is the sponsoring
4.7 nonprofit organization.

4.8 H. For wild turkey permit area 507, two additional permits per time periods
4.9 A and B are available for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt in
4.10 the Rockville County Park. Midwest Outdoors Unlimited is the sponsoring nonprofit
4.11 organization.

4.12 I. For wild turkey permit area 506, one additional permit per time periods A
4.13 and C is available for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt in the
4.14 Orwell Dam State Wildlife Area. Midwest Outdoors Unlimited is the sponsoring nonprofit
4.15 organization.

4.16 **6236.1075 SPECIAL HUNTS FOR MILITARY PERSONNEL.**

4.17 For the 2015 spring wild turkey season, the following permits are available for
4.18 special hunts for military personnel:

4.19 A. Camp Ripley Military Reservation is open to spring turkey hunting with
4.20 an unlimited number of permits.

4.21 B. For Arden Hills Army Training Site, within wild turkey permit area 510,
4.22 up to an additional 20 permits shall be issued for each of time periods A and C. The
4.23 Department of Military Affairs is the sponsoring organization.

4.24 **EFFECTIVE PERIOD.** The expedited emergency amendments to Minnesota Rules,
4.25 part 6230.0200, expire December 31, 2015. The expedited emergency amendments to

- 5.1 Minnesota Rules, part 6236.1060, and Minnesota Rules, part 6236.1075, expire July
- 5.2 1, 2015.
