1.4 Subpart 1. Open areas and permit quotas. The following wild turkey permit areas
1.5 are open for the 2017 spring wild turkey season. An unlimited number of permits are
1.6 available for periods C to F. Periods A and B have the following quotas on numbers
1.7 of permits:

1.24 Subp. 2. Permits for disability hunts. For the spring wild turkey season, the
1.25 following permits are available for disability hunts:

1.26 A. for wild turkey permit area 505, two additional permits per periods A and
1.27 B are available for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt on the

2.1 Minnesota Valley National Wildlife Refuge. Capable Partners is the sponsoring nonprofit
2.2 organization;

2.3 B. for wild turkey permit area 507, one additional permit per periods A and B is
2.4 available for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt on the Sand Prairie
2.5 Wildlife Management Area. Capable Partners is the sponsoring nonprofit organization;

2.6 C. Camp Ripley Military Reservation in wild turkey permit area 507 is open for
2.7 individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt. One nonhunting mentor must
2.8 accompany each disabled hunter. The Minnesota Disabled American Veterans Outdoors
2.9 Program is the sponsoring nonprofit organization;

2.10 D. for wild turkey permit area 507, eight additional permits per periods A and
2.11 B are available for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt. Midwest
2.12 Outdoors Unlimited is the sponsoring nonprofit organization; and

2.13 E. for wild turkey permit area 510, four additional permits per periods A and B
2.14 are available for individuals with disabilities participating in a special hunt on the Becklin
2.15 Homestead Park Wildlife Management Area. Capable Partners and the Isanti County
2.16 Sportsman's Club are the sponsoring nonprofit organizations.

2.17 **6236.1075 SPECIAL HUNTS FOR MILITARY PERSONNEL.**

2.18 For the spring wild turkey season, the following permits are available for special
2.19 hunts for military personnel:

2.20 A. Camp Ripley Military Reservation is open for persons with approval from
2.21 the Camp Ripley Department of Military Affairs; and

2.22 B. for Arden Hills Army Training Site in wild turkey permit area 507, up to
2.23 an additional 20 permits per periods A and B are available. The Department of Military
2.24 Affairs is the sponsoring organization.
