A person who has not applied for a wild turkey license through the lottery or 4.7 who applied for a license and was unsuccessful in the lottery may purchase a wild turkey 4.8 hunting license to hunt the spring turkey season during the third, fourth, fifth, or sixth, 4.9 seventh, or eighth time period. A wild turkey hunting license under this item is separate 4.10 from the normal lottery process.
