34.4 6232.2560 YOUTH SPECIAL DEER SEASONS.

Subpart 1. **Requirements.** Youths participating in youth special deer seasons must 34.5 obtain a license for taking deer by firearms, valid for any season option, by the beginning 34.6 date of the special season. A youth special season participant may take one deer, which 34.7 must be antlerless according to the bag limits under part 6232.0300, subpart 8, for the 34.8 corresponding deer permit area designation under part 6232.1750. One bonus permit may 34.9 be used. Any legal buck taken during the youth special deer season applies to the statewide 34.10 limit for legal bucks prescribed in part 6232.0300, subpart 8. An adult mentor age 18 or 34.11 older authorized by the youth's parent or guardian must accompany the youth hunter youth 34.12 hunters ages ten to 13 at all times during the hunt. The accompanying adult may not hunt 34.13 except when hunting in an early antlerless deer permit area.
