1.7 **Subp. 4a. Keystone Woods Wildlife Management Area; firearms restrictions.**

1.8 **A. Individuals may possess only nontoxic ammunition on their person at Keystone**
1.9 **Woods Wildlife Management Area in Washington County.**

1.10 **B. For purposes of this subpart, "nontoxic ammunition" means:**

1.11 **(1) steel shot;**

1.12 **(2) copper-plated, nickel-plated, or zinc-plated steel shot or projectile;**

1.13 **(3) shot made of other nontoxic material approved by the director of the**
1.14 **United States Fish and Wildlife Service according to Code of Federal Regulations, title 50,**
1.15 **section 20.21(j); or**

1.16 **(4) other projectile that does not contain lead.**

1.17 **C. Notwithstanding item A, a person who carries a pistol and possesses a valid**
1.18 **permit under Minnesota Statutes, section 624.714, may possess ammunition that does not**
1.19 **meet the requirements of item B, but the ammunition may not be used for taking wild animals**
1.20 **at Keystone Woods Wildlife Management Area.**

2.4 **EFFECTIVE PERIOD.** The expedited emergency amendment to Minnesota Rules, part
2.5 6230.0200, subpart 4a, is effective May 7, 2026. After the expedited emergency amendment
2.6 expires, the permanent rule again takes effect, subject to any permanent rule amendments
2.7 that have been adopted in the interim.
