It is needed because

When Minn. Statutes 84.946, Natural Resources Asset Preservation and Replacement, was passed the new category for natural resources asset preservation was not included in the list of exceptions with the other asset preservation categories. This proposal would add natural resources asset preservation to the list of exceptions and would provide consistency in how DNR construction projects are reviewed. This change is sought to ensure these projects are conducted in the most streamlined and efficient manner possible.

Major program elements

This bill adds language to include DNR natural resource asset preservation projects to the list of exceptions in Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 16B.335, subdivision 2.

Fiscal impacts

This proposal does not have a fiscal impact.

Statute Proposal

Natural Resource Asset Preservation Accounts

Sec 1. Amends M.S. 16B.335 to add natural resources preservation account projects to the list that is not required to provide notice to the senate Capital Investment and Finance Committee or the House of Representatives Capital Investment and Ways and Means Committees.
