


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
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### DNR Organizational Structure






### Division of Enforcement

- Enforces all natural resource laws including those related to game and fish, wetlands, aquatic plants, and the operation of watercraft, snowmobiles, all-terrain vehicles, and other recreational vehicles
- Regulates natural resource commercial operations
- Provides conservation and safety education programs.

#### FY2012-13 Budgeted Expenditures by Fund Enforcement \$68.5 Million




## ECOLOGICAL AND WATER RESOURCES



### Division of Ecological and Water Resources

- Ensures the long-term health of watersheds that support water quality and maintain water quality, biodiversity, and vital ecosystem services.
- Provides critical information and regulatory oversight to state and local governments and landowners to foster natural resources stewardship

#### FY2012-13 Budgeted Expenditures by Fund Ecological and Water Resources \$112.4 Million






## FISH AND WILDLIFE

- Helps preserve MN's fishing, hunting, and trapping heritage




## FORESTRY

### Division of Forestry

- Protects citizens, property, and natural resources from wildfire
- Provides a sustainable yield of forest resources for forest products, clean water, wildlife habitat, and recreation
- Manages School Trust surface resources (forest products, gravel)

#### FY2012-13 Budgeted Expenditures by Fund Forestry \$146.1 Million






## LANDS AND MINERALS




### Division of Lands and Minerals

#### FY2012-13 Budgeted Expenditures by Fund Lands and Minerals \$79.1 Million





## PARKS AND TRAILS
