1. For lands acquired in fee title that will be turned over to a public agency for long-term management:

- a. Provide a description of the work necessary to bring the land up to agency standards and an estimate of the associated cost.

This land is already owned by the city of Owatonna and is a part of the park system.

- b. What short- and long-term work is required to manage the land you acquire?

It is an undeveloped park. We hope to restore the historic flow of the streambed and protect the banks from erosion.

2. For enhancement/ restoration projects on public lands:

- a. Who is/will be the long-term manager for the project site?

Jeff McKay is the director of Parks and Recreation; Corky Ebeling is specifically in charge on all parks in the city of Owatonna.

- b. What short- and long-term maintenance work is required to sustain the habitat work you will do?

There are no immediate plans to develop this park - it will remain a natural area for the foreseeable future. To maintain this integrity we need to stabilize the stream bed and protect the banks from erosion.

- c. Who will complete this maintenance work, and how will it be funded?

The Owatonna city Parks and Recreation is responsible for maintenance. Both and Izaak Walton League and the Women of Today have adopted this stream under the MN DNR Adopt a Rivers program. They will continue to work together.

- d. Will the CPL funds supplant any existing funds?

There are no immediate plans to fund any other projects in this geographic area.



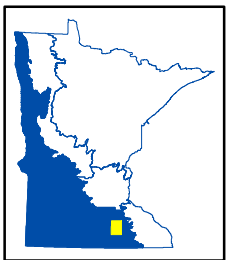
