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**Plant Groups (Physiognomy) Defined**  
**Aquatics** - floating, emergent, submerged  
**Climbers/vines and epiphytes** (grows on other plants)  
**Ferns and lycophytes** - spore-bearing plants  
**Forbs** - herbaceous flowering plants  
**Graminoids** - grasses, sedges, and rushes  
**Succulents** - cactus-like  
**Trees and shrubs** - woody plants  
**Mosses** - non-flowering plants that lack true roots

**Rare and Introduced Status Keys**  
**END** - Endangered (State), **E** - Endangered (Federal)  
**THR** - Threatened (State), **T** - Threatened (Federal)  
**SPC** - Special Concern  
**WL** - Watchlist

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\* - Introduced or \*\* - Undetermined

**Data Confidence Key**  
**1** - Vouchered record (specimen in herbarium collection)  
**2** - Vetted record (confirmed by DNR staff)  
**3** - Unverified record
